Dear Colleagues,

We invite you to participate to the 12th **International Colloquium “Romanian Academic Lexicography. The Challenges of Digitalization”**, organized by the Department of Lexicology and Lexicography of the “A. Philippide” Institute of Romanian Philology, in collaboration with the “A. Philippide” Cultural Association, both within the Iași Branch of the Romanian Academy.

This edition will take place on **May 25-26, 2023**, in **hybrid format**. The conference will take place at the Iași Branch of the Romanian Academy, Bd. Carol I, nr. 8. Online access data will be specified in the programme of the event.

This year’s meeting will focus on disseminating the most recent lexicographic research results from national and European projects, presenting and testing tools and resources for the writing of academic dictionaries and disseminating new scientific findings in the field of computerised and traditional Romanian Linguistics and Philology.

For this year’s edition, we invite you to participate in the following thematic sections:

- *Tezaurul lexical al limbii române* [*The Lexical Thesaurus of the Romanian Language*] – dedicated to the lexicographic projects of the Romanian Academy: *Dicționarul limbii române. Ediția a doua, revizuită și adăugită* [*The Dictionary of the Romanian Language. Second Edition, revised and updated*], *Dicționarul etimologic al limbii române* [*The Etymological Dictionary of the Romanian Language*], *Dicționarul explicativ al limbii române* [*The Explanatory Dictionary of the Romanian Language*] and *CLRE. Corpus lexicografic românesc electronic* [*CLRE. Romanian Electronic Lexicographic Corpus*] and others, followed by the round table *Present and perspectives in Romanian academic lexicography*,
- research results in the fields of lexicology and lexicography, with an emphasis on general linguistics and philology,
- national and international projects (funded by competition)¹, which also involve elements of computerisation of linguistic research on Romanian language – presentations and results:

Organisational details:

Papers may be presented in Romanian or in an international language (English, French, Spanish or Italian). To ensure effective communication, presentations in PPT (PPTX) format should be in an international language (English or French). The time allowed for a presentation is 30 minutes (20 minutes for presentation itself and 10 minutes for discussion).

The studies or articles resulting from this year's conference will be published before the next edition of the colloquium, in a volume that we will propose to a prestigious publisher house.

The final programme will be decided by the **5th of May 2023**, following dialogues with the authors whose papers have been accepted by the Scientific Committee.

The participation fee is 10 euro. This amount will cover the publication costs of the colloquium volume. The participation fee will be paid after acceptance of the paper by the organizers and will be deposited to the account of the “A. Philippide” Cultural Association.
